

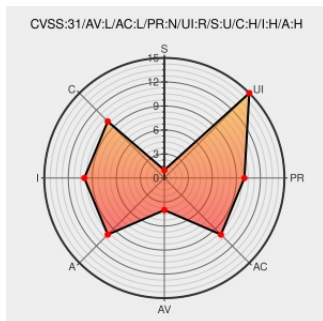

Certain versions of [HtmlDoc](#) from [HtmlDoc Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A flaw was discovered in htmldoc 1.9.12 in function parse_paragraph in ps-pdf.cxx ,this flaw possibly allows possible code execution and a denial of service via a crafted file.

CVE-2021-34119 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
