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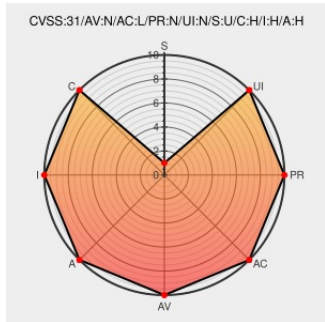

A SQL INJECTION vulnerability in Sourcecodester Simple Food Website 1.0 allows a remote attacker to Bypass Authentication and become Admin.
