

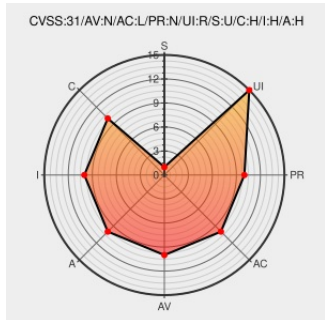

Certain versions of [Newsplugin](#) from [lpdgroup](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The NewsPlugin WordPress plugin is vulnerable to Cross-Site Request Forgery via the `handle_save_style` function found in the `~/news-plugin.php` file which allows attackers to inject arbitrary web scripts, in versions up to and including 1.0.18.

CVE-2021-34631 has been assigned by security@wordfence.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **NewsPlugin** - **NewsPlugin** version `<= 1.0.18`
