

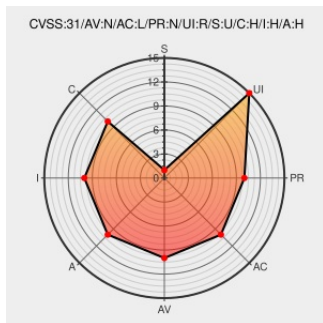

Certain versions of [Sola-newsletters](#) from [Sola-newsletters Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Nifty Newsletters WordPress plugin is vulnerable to Cross-Site Request Forgery via the sola_nl_wp_head function found in the ~/sola-newsletters.php file which allows attackers to inject arbitrary web scripts, in versions up to and including 4.0.23.

CVE-2021-34634 has been assigned by security@wordfence.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **SolaPlugins - Nifty Newsletters** version <= 4.0.23
