Certain versions of [Wp Seo Tags](#) from [Wp Seo Tags Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The WP SEO Tags WordPress plugin is vulnerable to Reflected Cross-Site Scripting via the saq\_txt\_the\_filter parameter in the ~/wp-seo-tags.php file which allows attackers to inject arbitrary web scripts, in versions up to and including 2.2.7.

CVE-2021-34665 has been assigned by security@wordfence.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **WP SEO Tags** - **WP SEO Tags** version <= 2.2.7
