

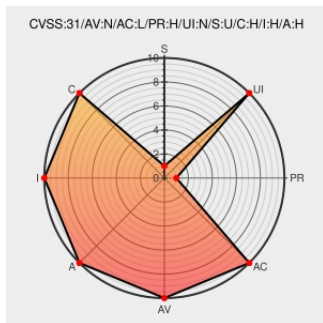

Certain versions of [Balero Cms](#) from [Balero Cms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

File Upload vulnerability in balerocms-src 0.8.3 allows remote attackers to run arbitrary code via rich text editor on /admin/main/mod-blog page.

CVE-2021-35290 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.

CVSS3 Score: **7.2 - HIGH**
