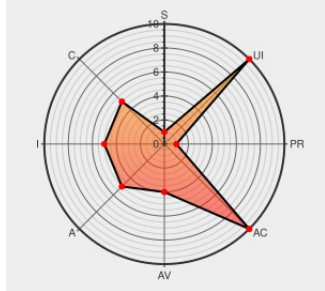

Certain versions of **Fortios** from **Fortinet** contain the following vulnerability:

A Hidden Functionality in Fortinet FortiOS 7.x before 7.0.1, FortiOS 6.4.x before 6.4.7 allows attacker to Execute unauthorized code or commands via specific hex read/write operations.

CVE-2021-36169 has been assigned by  psirt@fortinet.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
