

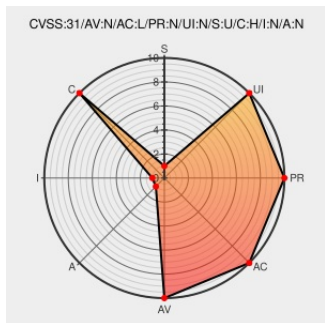

Incorrect Access Control issue discovered in tpcms 3.2 allows remote attackers to view sensitive information via path in application URL.
