

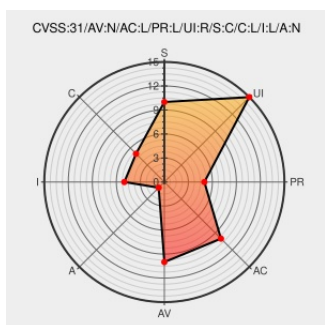

Cross Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability in yzmcms 6.1 allows attackers to steal user cookies via image clipping function.
