

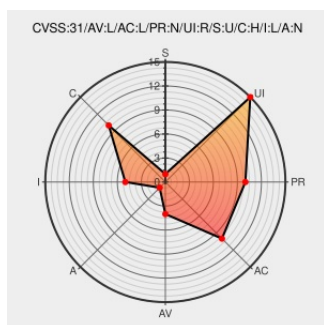

Certain versions of [Emuse - Eservices / Envoice](#) from [Emuse - Eservices Envoice Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Emuse - eServices / eNvoice Exposure Of Private Personal Information due to lack of identification mechanisms and predictable IDs an attacker can scrape all the files on the service.

CVE-2021-36723 has been assigned by cna@cyber.gov.il to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
