

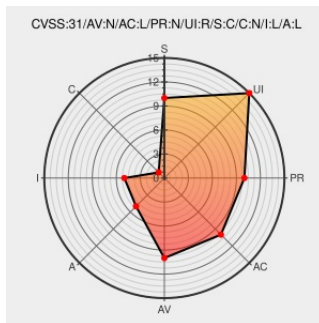

Certain versions of [Tarteaucitron.js - Cookies Legislation Gdpr](#) from [Tarteaucitron.js - Cookies Legislation Gdpr Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) vulnerability leading to Cross-Site Scripting (XSS) discovered in tarteaucitron.js – Cookies legislation & GDPR WordPress plugin (versions <= 1.5.4), vulnerable parameters "tarteaucitronEmail" and "tarteaucitronPass".

CVE-2021-36887 has been assigned by audit@patchstack.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Tarteaucitron - tarteaucitron.js – Cookies legislation & GDPR (WordPress plugin)** version <= 1.5.4
