

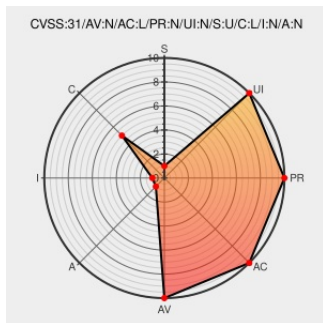

Certain versions of **Emui** from **Huawei** contain the following vulnerability:

There is an Improper permission control vulnerability in Huawei Smartphone. Successful exploitation of this vulnerability may allow attempts to obtain certain device information.

CVE-2021-37056 has been assigned by psirt@huawei.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
