

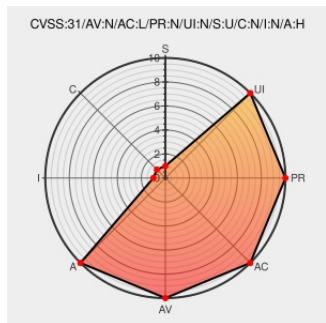

There is a Incomplete Cleanup vulnerability in Huawei Smartphone. Successful exploitation of this vulnerability may lead to kernel restart.
