

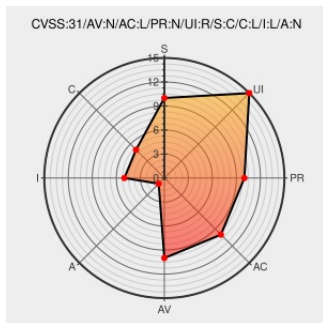

Certain versions of [Comos](#) from [Siemens](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability has been identified in COMOS V10.2 (All versions only if web components are used), COMOS V10.3 (All versions < V10.3.3.3 only if web components are used), COMOS V10.4 (All versions < V10.4.1 only if web components are used). The COMOS Web component of COMOS accepts arbitrary code as attachment to tasks.

This could allow an attacker to inject malicious code that is executed when loading the attachment.

CVE-2021-37195 has been assigned by [S](#) productcert@siemens.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
