Certain versions of [Saraban](#) from [Softvibe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SoftVibe SARABAN for INFOMA 1.1 is vulnerable to stored cross-site scripting (XSS) that allows users to store scripts in certain fields (e.g. subject, description) of the document form.

CVE-2021-38695 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
