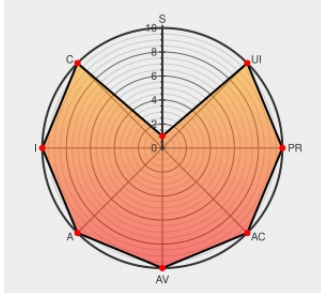

An issue was discovered in /Upload/admin/admin_notify.php in Seacms 11.4 allows attackers to execute arbitrary php code via the notify1 parameter when the action parameter equals set.
