

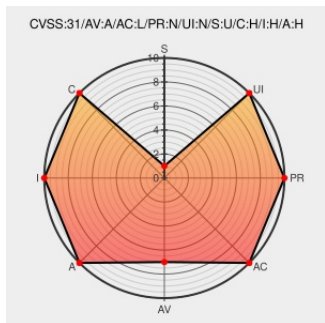

Certain versions of [Android](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In Bluetooth, there is a possible way to access the a2dp audio control switch due to a missing permission check. This could lead to local escalation of privilege with no additional execution privileges needed. User interaction is not needed for exploitation. Product: Android Versions: Android-12L Android ID: A-181962322

CVE-2021-39772 has been assigned by [security@android.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
