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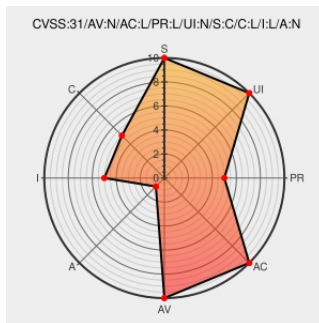

Certain versions of [Concrete Cms](#) from [Concretecms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A SSRF issue was discovered in Concrete CMS through 8.5.5. Users can access forbidden files on their local network. A user with permissions to upload files from external sites can upload a URL that redirects to an internal resource of any file type. The redirect is followed and loads the contents of the file from the redirected-to server.

Files of disallowed types can be uploaded.

CVE-2021-40109 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
