

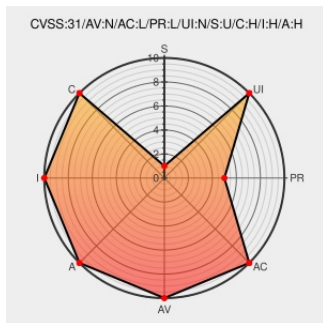

Certain versions of [Piwigo](#) from [Piwigo](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Piwigo v11.5 was discovered to contain a SQL injection vulnerability via the parameter pwg_token in /admin/batch_manager_global.php.

CVE-2021-40313 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
