Certain versions of [Audition](#) from [Adobe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Adobe Audition version 14.4 (and earlier) is affected by a Null pointer dereference vulnerability when parsing a specially crafted file. An unauthenticated attacker could leverage this vulnerability to achieve an application denial-of-service in the context of the current user.

Exploitation of this issue requires user interaction in that a victim must

open a malicious file.

CVE-2021-40742 has been assigned by psirt@adobe.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
