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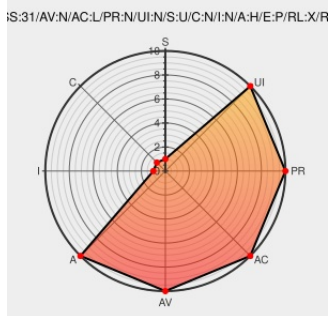

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Certain versions of **Fortiweb** from **Fortinet** contain the following vulnerability:

A uncontrolled resource consumption in Fortinet FortiWeb version 6.4.1 and below, 6.3.15 and below allows an unauthenticated attacker to make the httpd daemon unresponsive via huge HTTP packets

CVE-2021-41014 has been assigned by psirt@fortinet.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
