

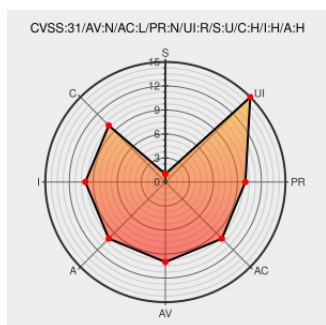

Certain versions of [Ecs Router Controller-ecs](#) from [Ecoa](#) contain the following vulnerability:

ECOAS controller has a Cross-Site Request Forgery vulnerability, thus authenticated attacker can remotely place a forged request at a malicious web page and execute CRUD commands (GET, POST, PUT, DELETE) to perform arbitrary operations in the system.

CVE-2021-41295 has been assigned by [cve@cert.org.tw](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
