

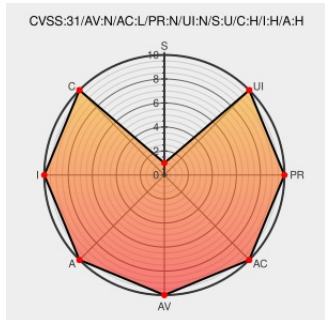

Certain versions of [Simple Cashiering System](#) from [Simple Cashiering System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple SQL Injection vulnerabilities exist in Sourcecodester Simple Cashiering System (POS) 1.0 via the (1) Product Code in the pos page in cashiering. (2) id parameter in manage_products and the (3) t paramater in actions.php.

CVE-2021-41492 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
