

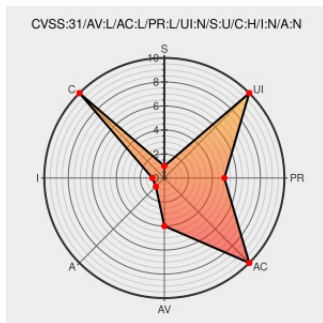

MELAG FTP Server 2.2.0.4 stores unencrypted passwords of FTP users in a local configuration file.
