

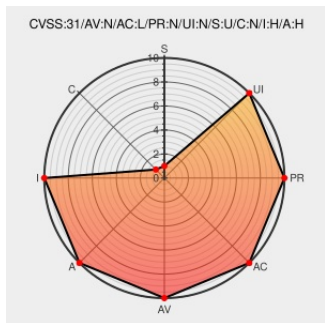

Certain versions of [Baicloud-cms](#) from [Baicloud-cms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

BaiCloud-cms v2.5.7 is affected by an arbitrary file deletion vulnerability, which allows an attacker to delete arbitrary files on the server through `/user/ppsave.php`.

CVE-2021-41729 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
