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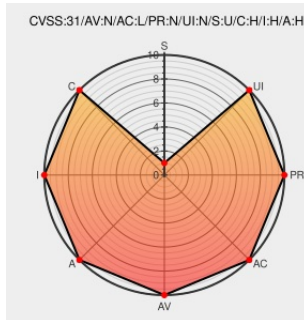

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Certain versions of [Recruitment Management System](#) from [Recruitment Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Company's Recruitment Management System in id=2 of the parameter from view_vacancy app on-page appears to be vulnerable to SQL injection. The payloads 19424269' or '1309'='1309 and 39476597' or '2917'='2923 were each submitted in the id parameter.

These two requests resulted in different responses, indicating that the input is being incorporated into a SQL query in an unsafe way.

CVE-2021-41931 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
