

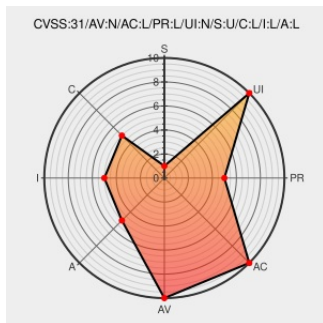

Certain versions of [Lmeve](#) from [Lmeve Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability was found in roxlukas LMeve and classified as critical. Affected by this issue is some unknown functionality of the component Login Page. The manipulation of the argument X-Forwarded-For leads to sql injection. The attack may be launched remotely. The name of the patch is 29e1ead3bb1c1fad53b77dfc14534496421c5b5d. It is

recommended to apply a patch to fix this issue. The identifier of this vulnerability is VDB-216176.

CVE-2021-4246 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
