

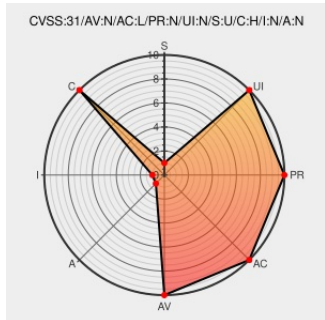

Certain versions of [Jeedom](#) from [Jeedom](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In Jeedom through 4.1.19, a bug allows a remote attacker to bypass API access and retrieve users credentials.

CVE-2021-42557 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
