

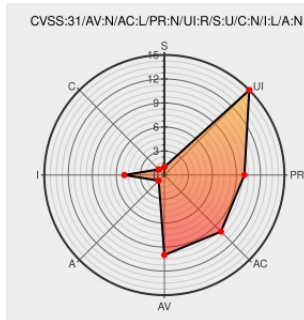

Certain versions of [Pyambic-pentameter](#) from [Pyambic-pentameter Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability, which was classified as problematic, was found in katlings pyambic-pentameter. Affected is an unknown function. The manipulation leads to cross-site request forgery. It is possible to launch the attack remotely. The name of the patch is

974f21aa1b2527ef39c8afe1a5060548217deca8. It is recommended to

apply a patch to fix this issue. VDB-216498 is the identifier assigned to this vulnerability.

CVE-2021-4275 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
