

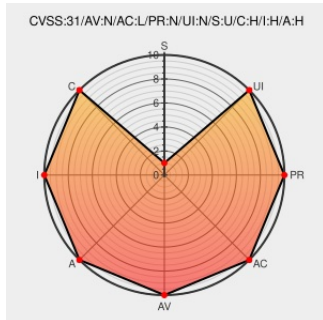

Certain versions of [Ulcc-core](#) from [Ulcc-core Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability was found in eprintsug ulcc-core. It has been declared as critical. Affected by this vulnerability is an unknown functionality of the file cgi/toolbox/toolbox. The manipulation of the argument password leads to command injection. The attack can be launched remotely. The name of the patch is 811edaae81eb044891594f00062a828f51b22cb1.

It is recommended to apply a patch to fix this issue. The associated identifier of this vulnerability is VDB-217447.

CVE-2021-4304 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
