Certain versions of [Bbs](#) from [Diyhi](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An Archive Extraction (AKA "Zip Slip") vulnerability exists in bbs 5.3 in the UpgradeNow function in UpgradeManageAction.java, which unzips the arbitrary uploaded zip file without checking filenames. The vulnerability is exploited using a specially crafted archive that holds directory traversal filenames (e.g. ../../evil.exe).

CVE-2021-43099 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
