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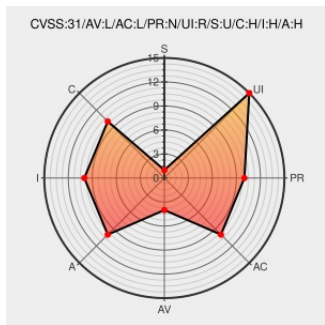

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Certain versions of [Mantisbt](#) from [Mantisbt](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Lack of Neutralization of Formula Elements in the CSV API of MantisBT before 2.25.3 allows an unprivileged attacker to execute code or gain access to information when a user opens the csv_export.php generated CSV file in Excel.

CVE-2021-43257 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
