

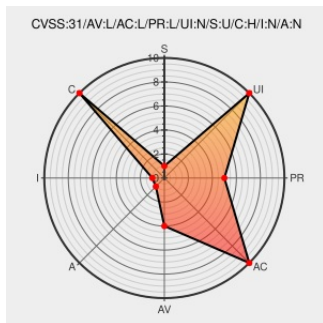

Certain versions of [Titus Data Classification](#) from [Helpsystems](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Labeling tool in Titus Classification Suite 18.8.1910.140 allows users to avoid the generation of a classification label by using Excel's safe mode.

CVE-2021-43708 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
