

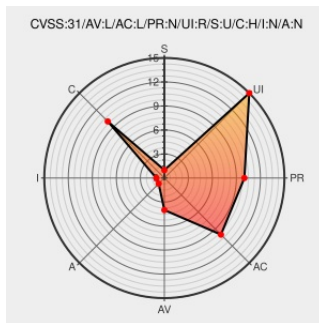

Certain versions of **Jt2go** from **Siemens** contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability has been identified in JT2Go (All versions < V13.2.0.5), Teamcenter Visualization (All versions < V13.2.0.5). The Tiff_Loader.dll is vulnerable to an out of bounds read past the end of an allocated buffer when parsing TIFF files. An attacker could leverage this vulnerability to leak information in the context of the current

process.

CVE-2021-44010 has been assigned by **S** productcert@siemens.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
