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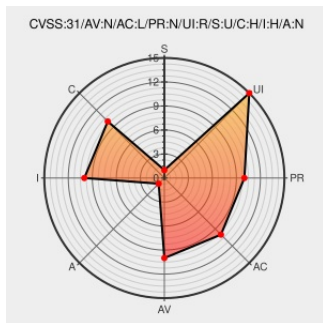

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Certain versions of [Experience Manager](#) from [Adobe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

AEM's Cloud Service offering, as well as version 6.5.10.0 (and below) are affected by a stored Cross-Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability that could be abused by an attacker to inject malicious scripts into vulnerable form fields. Malicious JavaScript may be executed in a victim's browser when they browse to the page containing the

vulnerable field.

CVE-2021-44176 has been assigned by psirt@adobe.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
