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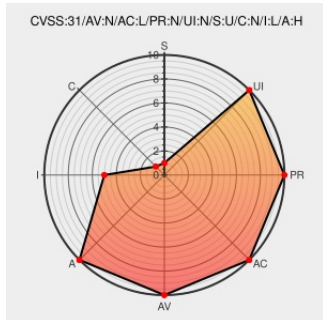

Certain versions of [Fortessa Fbtld](#) from [Cef](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Incorrect permissions in the Bluetooth Services in the Fortessa FTBTL Smart Lock as of 12-13-2022 allows a remote attacker to disable the lock via an unauthenticated edit to the lock name.

CVE-2021-44905 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
