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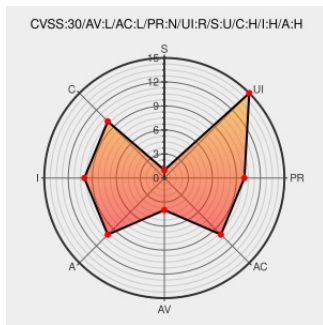

Certain versions of [Acrobat Reader](#) from [Adobe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Acrobat Reader DC version 21.007.20099 (and earlier), 20.004.30017 (and earlier) and 17.011.30204 (and earlier) are affected by an out-of-bounds read vulnerability when parsing a crafted file, which could result in a read past the end of an allocated memory structure. An attacker could leverage this vulnerability to execute code in the context

of the current user. Exploitation of this issue requires user interaction in that a victim must open a malicious file.

CVE-2021-45060 has been assigned by psirt@adobe.com to track the vulnerability
