

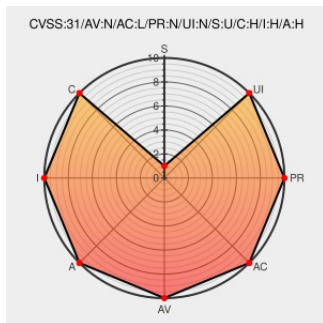

Certain versions of [Node-windows](#) from [Node-windows Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

lib/cmd.js in the node-windows package before 1.0.0-beta.6 for Node.js allows command injection via the PID parameter.

CVE-2021-45459 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
