

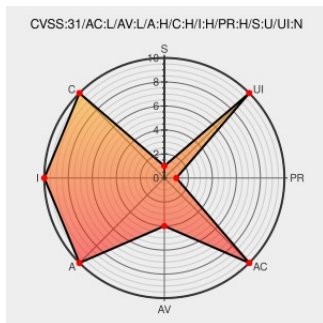

NETGEAR R8000 devices before 1.0.4.76 are affected by command injection by an authenticated user.
