

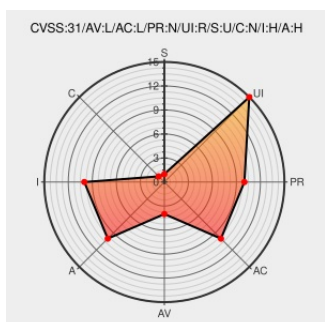

MCMS v5.2.5 was discovered to contain an arbitrary file deletion vulnerability via the component oldFileName.
