Certain versions of [Mcms](#) from [Mingsoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

File upload vulnerability in mingSoft MCMS through 5.2.5, allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted jspk webshell to net.mingsoft.basic.action.web.FileAction#upload.

CVE-2021-46386 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
