

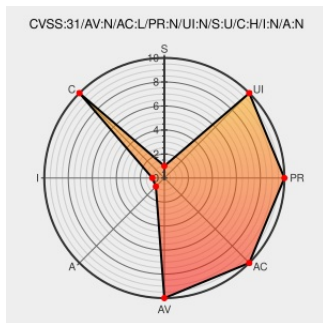

Certain versions of [Ts-550 Evo](#) from [Franklinfueling](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Franklin Fueling Systems FFS T5 Series 1.8.7.7299 is affected by an unauthenticated directory traversal vulnerability, which allows an attacker to obtain sensitive information.

CVE-2021-46421 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
