

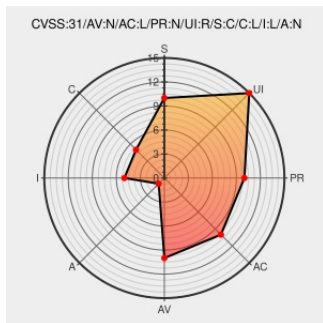

Certain versions of [Advanced Image Sitemap](#) from [Advanced Image Sitemap Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Advanced Image Sitemap WordPress plugin through 1.2 does not sanitise and escape the PHP_SELF PHP variable before outputting it back in an attribute in an admin page, leading to Reflected Cross-Site Scripting.

CVE-2022-1216 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown - Advanced Image Sitemap** version <= 1.2
