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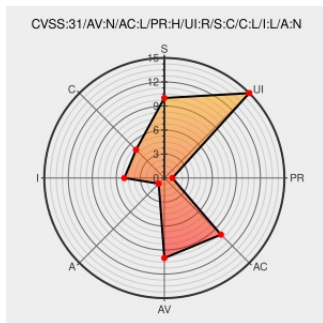

Certain versions of [Easy Faq With Expanding Text](#) from [Easy Faq With Expanding Text Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Easy FAQ with Expanding Text WordPress plugin through 3.2.8.3.1 does not sanitise and escape its settings, allowing high privilege users to perform Cross-Site Scripting attacks when `unfiltered_html` is disallowed

CVE-2022-1395 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
