Certain versions of [Rename Wp-login](#) from [Rename Wp-login Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Rename wp-login.php WordPress plugin through 2.6.0 does not have CSRF check in place when updating the secret login URL, which could allow attackers to make a logged in admin change them via a CSRF attack

CVE-2022-1732 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
