

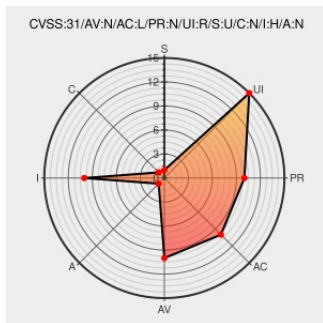

Certain versions of [New User Email Set Up](#) from [New User Email Set Up Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The New User Email Set Up WordPress plugin through 0.5.2 does not have CSRF check in place when updating its settings, which could allow attackers to make a logged in admin change them via a CSRF attack

CVE-2022-1790 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown - New User Email Set Up** version <= 0.5.2
