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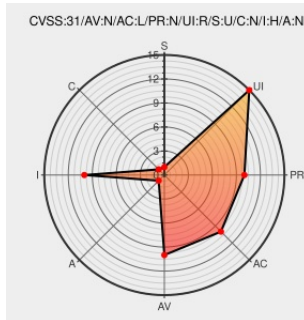

Certain versions of [Inline Google Maps](#) from [Inline Google Maps Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Inline Google Maps WordPress plugin through 5.11 does not have CSRF check in place when updating its settings, which could allow attackers to make a logged in admin change them via a CSRF attack, and lead to Stored Cross-Site Scripting due to the lack of sanitisation and escaping

CVE-2022-1829 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown - Inline Google Maps** version <= 5.11
