

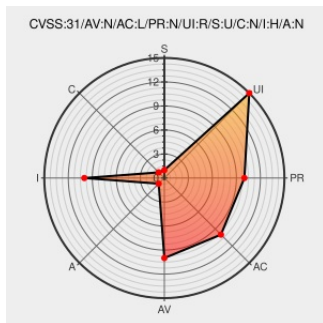

Certain versions of [Mailpress](#) from [Mailpress Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The MailPress WordPress plugin through 7.2.1 does not have CSRF checks in various places, which could allow attackers to make a logged in admin change the settings, purge log files and more via CSRF attacks

CVE-2022-1843 has been assigned by [contact@wpscan.com](mailto:contact@wpscan.com) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown** - **MailPress** version **<= 7.2.1**

CVSS3 Score: **6.5 - MEDIUM**
