

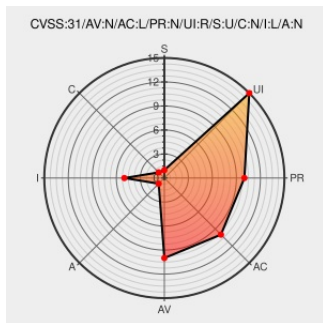

Certain versions of [Tiny Contact Form](#) from [Tiny Contact Form Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Tiny Contact Form WordPress plugin through 0.7 does not have CSRF check in place when updating its settings, which could allow attackers to make a logged in admin change them via a CSRF attack

CVE-2022-1846 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown - Tiny Contact Form** version <= 0.7

CVSS3 Score: **4.3 - MEDIUM**
