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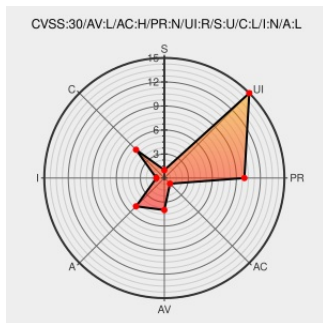

Buffer Over-read in GitHub repository [bfabiszewski/libmobi](#) prior to 0.11.

CVE-2022-1908 has been assigned by security@huntr.dev to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **bfabiszewski** - **bfabiszewski/libmobi** version < 0.11
